**Parents/carers of registered pupils attending the school may offer themselves for election.**

**Nominations for parent governors' vacancies are made by parent/carers of pupils registered at the school and should candidates exceed the number of vacancies a ballot will be held.**

**Parents governors can serve for a term of up to four years irrespective of how long their child remains as a registered pupil of the school.**

**Candidates must not be paid to work in the school for more than 500 hours in any consecutive 12-month period at the time of election.**
