

The Trust's thriving Teaching School Hub and SCITT (School-Centred Initial Teacher Training) programmes provide unparalleled opportunities for professional development, collaboration and leadership. As the creators of the innovative Phonics Steps programme, the Trust is a national leader in early literacy, helping to shape educational standards.

NCFE CACHE Level 3 Diploma for Working in the Early Years Sector (Early Years Educator):

We are an NCFE approved centre delivering this qualification for staff working in our early years sector as well as those outside SFET, providing colleagues with the knowledge, skills and understanding needed to work in an early years setting and be included in staff to child ratios.





Post-graduate Apprenticeship End Point Assessment Organisation

SFET and SSF SCITT are an End Point Assessment Organisation (EPAO) with responsibility for conducting the final assessment of apprentices trained by other teacher training providers. We currently have a team of 60 end point assessors to address both local and national demand and this year are completing 554 assessments across the country.

Targeted CPD for Teaching Assistants: Supporting Teaching and Learning in Schools:

Our Teaching Assistant Development Programme is an online course to provide participants with an increased understanding of how to support effective teaching and learning under everyday classroom conditions and when delivering structured interventions out of class to ensure they have a positive impact on pupil engagement and attainment.

South Farnham SCITT is an Ofsted Outstanding (July 2023) primary and secondary Initial Teacher Training provider, nationally recognised within the DfE to be at the forefront of school-based training. As the area's largest cross-phase provider and with over 20 years' experience leading ITT, our wide partnership of schools trains over 200 teachers annually across Surrey, Hampshire, Sussex,Berkshire and London, bringing stability and continuity to the primary and secondary school workforce so that children across the region experience teaching of the highest quality.



Ranked No.3 in the UK for School Direct programmes and No.1 for employment rates, Ofsted praised the 'exceptional team around the trainee' that harmoniously provides expert and skilful guidance for trainees and ultimately ensures trainees are 'exceptionally well equipped to start their teaching career'.

Little steps to big results

Phonics Steps, developed by South Farnham Educational Trust, is a DfE validated full Systematic Synthetic Phonics (SSP) programme which equips children with the necessary skills, knowledge and positive learning behaviours to become expert readers and writers. Our schools have developed a highly effective Letters and Sounds approach over many years, with Phonics Screening Check results consistently amongst the top three per cent in the country.

Help shape the educational standards in your school!



Phonics Steps combines best practices from expert teachers across the Trust's partner schools, is approved by the DfE and works in collaboration with Oxford University Press. The programme includes an intervention programme called Little Leaps designed to ensure accelerated progress for the most vulnerable pupils, particularly those in Key Stages 1 and 2. Additionally, a secondary school programme, Phonics Steps+, is available to support older pupils in developing their reading skills, ensuring that no child is left behind.
