

# Ski school

- Groups will be taught by fully qualified instructors
- Students will be split into groups based on ability
- Group sizes will be an average 12 students to one instructor
- 5 days skiing with 4 hours of ski instruction each day
- Only students from BHCS will be skiing in your ski groups



# Risk management

Skiing is inherently a risky activity. Please be aware that there are some key risks that we will manage, but you must be aware of:

- 1) **The journey:** down to Kitzbuhel, Austria – stop offs at service stations
- 2) **The site:** The hotel is on a busy road. This is a bus route and a major thoroughfare. Cross the road very carefully!
- 3) **The Activity:** Skiing can be dangerous. Know the ski cross code. Do not think you have mastered it after 3 days!
- 4) **Decisions:** Behaviour, timings, expectations

# Ski Lessons - 10th, 11th, 12th March

Tuesday 10th March – year 8 & 9 boys

Wednesday 11th March – year 8 & 9 girls

Thursday 12th March – all year 10 & 11

- Gloves, long sleeve tops and trousers/tracksuit bottoms

# Key Information

## Timings of the Trip – plan for Friday 27th March

School day as normal – half day

Students meet in the playground at 2.30pm, collect bags and take them to playground and start to load coaches as directed by staff (one group at a time)

Students start to board coaches at approximately 3.15pm (4.15pm depart)

# Key Information

## What to pack & how much money do I need (bank)

Lots of thin layers, salopettes, thermals, gloves, goggles/sunglasses, ski jacket, ski socks, a wacky sock for the skis  
Clothes for the resort / evening wear

## Importance of punctuality – PBG TIME!

We do not want to be waiting for anybody!! Punctuality is essential on the trip.

## Importance of Food & Sleep

Skiing is a physically demanding sport

The hotel will cater for dietary needs but students must be prepared to try new food.

Meal time expectations – no phones

## Passports, GHICs & Money

Passport, GHICs & Spending Money must be brought to reception two weeks before departure

**(Monday 16th March) – Envelope marked ‘Ski Trip 2026, Student Name and year group’**

These will be kept in the hotel safe and staff will look after passports in transit
